If your child claims that their reader is 'too easy', please ask them some questions about the text as they read and after they finish. For example, 'There was a big problem in the middle of this book. Can you tell me what the problem was?', or 'How do you think character X felt when Y happened?' Reading fluency is great, but we also want our children to be able to interpret events in the text.
